

This case describes the clinical course of a 25-year-old patient presenting for her 16 week OB check who was emergently diagnosed with stage 4 melanoma with metastasis to the oral cavity, liver, and skin. The young age of the patient and rapid advancement of the disease make this case worthy of attention. The study of this patient is designed to contribute to the actively growing body of literature on the potential relationship between pregnancy and melanoma, which is not currently understood. The goal of this case report is to provide further data and context to current literature, which is divided on whether there is a relationship between melanoma and pregnancy and whether a potential relationship is clinically relevant.
